**FALL INTO AUTUMN IN OLD QUEBEC CITY,  
WITH VISITS TO ILES d' ORLEANS, SAINTE-ANNE-DE-  
BEAUPRE, CHEZ MARIE'S & CANYON SAINT-ANNE**

***Sunday October 5:*** We will begin our "Picture-Perfect Autumn Vacation" by traveling to "Old Historical Quebec City". We will be making several coffee-stops, as well as lunch, as we travel along today. Arriving late afternoon, we will check into the beautiful Hotel Quebec which we will make our home for the next 3 nights. I have arranged a delicious Group Dinner for you this evening at our Hotel (included).

***Monday October 6:*** After a restful night we will enjoy a full American Breakfast at the hotel (included). As we start our first day adventure in Quebec, we will welcome onboard a local Tour Guide who will enlighten us this morning with a Historical Tour of Old Quebec. The highlights include-The Plains of Abraham, Cape Diamond, The Joan of Arc Garden, Grande-Allee, Parliament, Place d'Armes, Old Quebec, Chateau Frontenac, Place Royale and much more! This afternoon you will have free time to enjoy lunch on your own at one of their quaint Café's. You will also have ample time to take in some shopping and sight-seeing, as you go back in time exploring Old Quebec City with its beautiful Architectural Heritage buildings. Take some time to visit Hotel Frontenac to experience a touch of Europe Ambiance. (built in 1892 – CP Rail) As the afternoon come to an end, we will make our way back to the hotel. Supper tonight will be on your own. Restaurant in Hotel as well as within walking distance of the hotel.

***Tuesday October 7:*** After another restful night we will enjoy another full American Breakfast before departing the Hotel for another full day of adventure. We will take a 55 min drive along the scenic St. Lawrence River making our first stop at the Canyon Sainte-Anne... Explore the imposing 74-metre-high Sainte-Anne waterfall rumbling into its 1.2 billion, year old notch. Go across one of the highest pedestrian bridges in Quebec- 55 meters high! Discover the giant potholes, rainbows and beautiful flora. A shuttle bus is available to take you back and forth from the Falls' trail. There are trails accessible to people with reduced mobility. End your time here visiting the gift shop and café. Late morning we will depart and travel a short distance to Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupre where you can have lunch on your own. After Lunch you will be able to spend some time visiting the Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupre and the wooded hillside which has a Memorial Chapel and the Way of the Cross depicted with life –sized Stations of the Cross.

**The Basilica has been credited by the Catholic Church with many miracles of curing the sick and disabled. It is an important sanctuary which receives about a half-million pilgrims each year.**

**Early afternoon we will take the old Kings Highway with its very narrow country roads to a unique little place called Chez Marie where you are in for a real treat.**

**Mid Afternoon we will continue towards Quebec City, but first we will visit the Iles d'Orleans which celebrates Quebec's rural tradition with its gorgeous scenery stretching along the banks of the St. Lawrence River. You will experience the rich and vibrant culture of this Island jewel which is the birthplace of New France. The Island is noted for its rich soil which grows ample vegetables and fruit. We will pass by beautiful Vineyards and Strawberry fields, with a special stop at a Strawberry Farm. Strawberries are grown here until late September so let's hope there are still a few left for a treat!**

**As our Afternoon comes to an end and we leave the quaint Iles d'Orleans, take notice of the magnificent view of the Montmorency Falls as we pass over the bridge to the mainland. The Falls are 83 Meters Tall, a whopping 30 meters higher than Niagara Falls.**

**Arriving back at our hotel late afternoon, we will have time to freshen up before enjoying a delicious Farewell Dinner @ the Hotel (included).**

**Wednesday October 8: After Breakfast this morning, with much regrets we will say good-bye to our new adventures here in Quebec, but will take with us many new memories and friendships which will last a life time.**

**As we travel towards home today, we will take several breaks along the way arriving home early evening.**
